## ROTATION REQUIREMENTS FOR INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

- Students must be in one of the last 2 years of their Medicine studies
- Students must belong to a partner university or participate from a international mobility program the University of Murcia is member.
- Language:** although an official exam or certificate is not required a minimum command of the Spanish language is more than recommendable. Students must send a statement of purpose in Spanish (max. 500 words). Those having studied Spanish previously must send language proficiency report from the instructor.
- Rotations:** last 3-4 weeks and can take place in June-July or during our first semester (September-January). An extension can be possible providing availability at the Medical Service involved in the rotation.
- Students:** must be in their last year of their studies in Medicine according to the home university academic system.
- Applications:** students must send an application form together with an official transcript of records, 2 letters of recommendation, a passport photocopy and a passport size picture. Applications must be submitted at least 3 months in advance so as to have the approval of the academic co-ordinator of the rotation and fulfill Spanish visa requirements. The International Relations Office at the University of Murcia will issue a letter of acceptance upon confirmation from the academic supervisor.
- Housing:** students will be accommodated in a double appartments in a Residence Hall near downtown.
