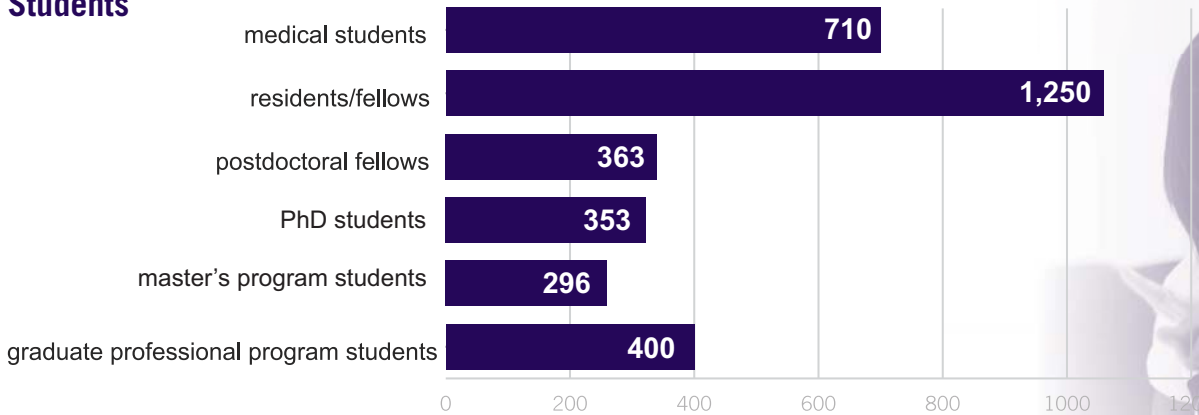

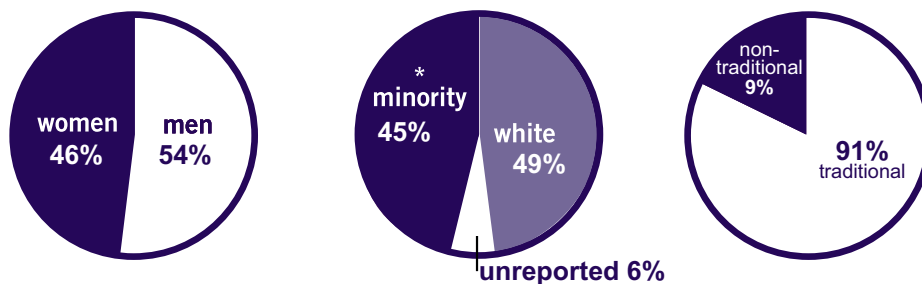
Curriculum Renewal
