The Center for Global Health integrates global health education programming and faculty research initiatives within the Feinberg School of Medicine (FSM), and encourages medical students and McGaw Medical Center residents to engage in global health in a meaningful way via research projects, supervised clinical work, and public health projects at affiliated and unaffiliated universities, health clinics, and INGOs around the world. Additionally, the center provides a space for NU faculty and research professionals with global health interests to collaborate on research opportunities and new proposals.

The Center for Global Health strives to adopt a multidisciplinary approach to global health to promote the skills, knowledge and expertise that will increasingly be required of future medical professionals. The challenges that medical students and residents will face over the course of their careers will require an interdisciplinary approach to global health challenges as national boundaries become less critical factors relating to disease burdens across populations. Many of the lessons learned from a global health experience, relating to health equity issues, ethics, and cultural competency are core skills that all physicians will need. To these ends, the Center for Global Health facilitates medical education, clinical, and research opportunities for the FSM community.
