9:30 am-12:30 pm **Session 1: Oncology Rehabilitation 101 across the Continuum of Care**

presented by Toni Sander, PT, DPT, MS, CLT-LANA (MS'87)

This introductory seminar will discuss the pathophysiology of cancer and the adverse effects of common cancer treatments as they pertain to exercise. Case studies will be used to develop exercise prescriptions for patients across the continuum of cancer care.

Intra-articular hip disorders (IAHD), such as labral tears and cartilage injury, can cause major functional restrictions in the young adult and may be a precursor to osteoarthritis. This course will provide an overview of the proposed risk factors associated with IAHD including bony abnormalities, movement impairments, and activity participation. Movement system diagnoses related to IAHD and treatment specific to each diagnosis will be discussed.
