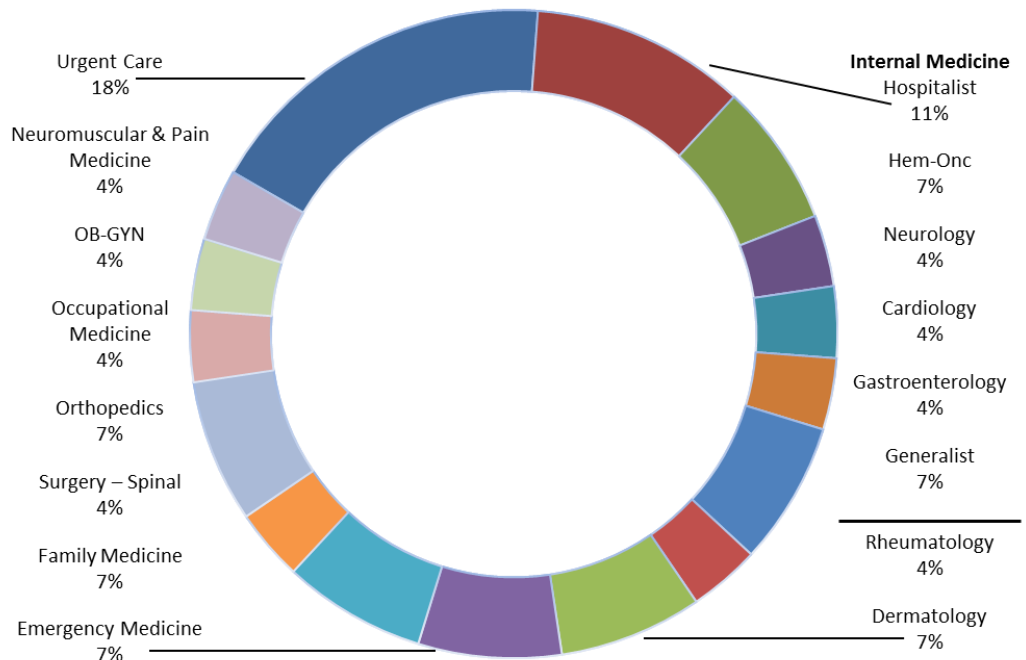

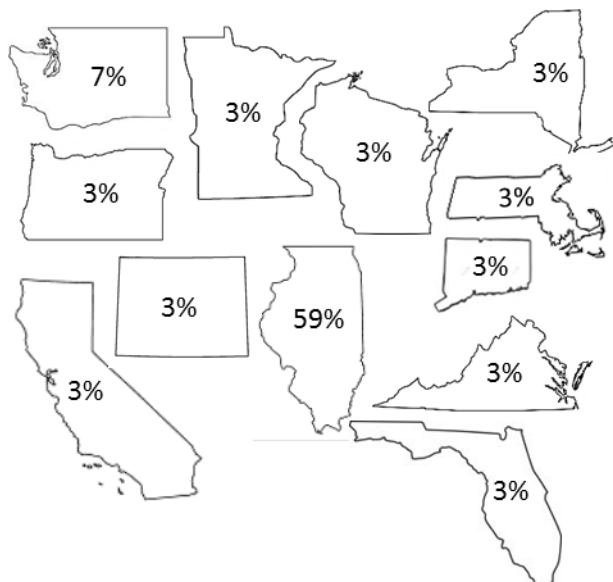

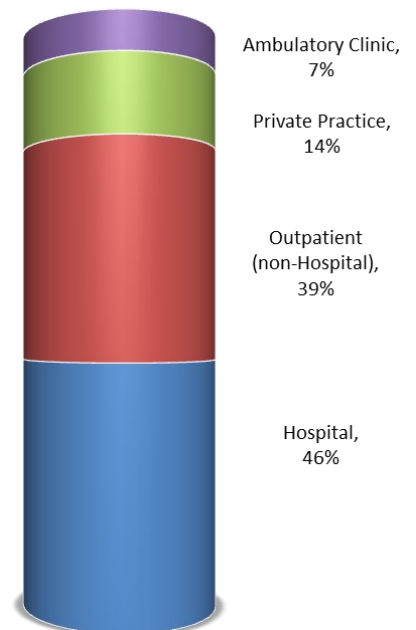
Area of Specialty
