

A MESSAGE FROM THE CHAIR JULIUS P.A. DEWALD, PT, PHD

Our PTHMS community of students (DPT, DPT/PhD, DPT/MPH, PhD), faculty, researchers, residents, fellows, and staff have so much to be thankful for as we approach the end of 2023 and begin looking

forward to our 2027 centennial celebration as the oldest continuously accredited physical therapy school in the U.S.

NUPTHMS is one of only 7 physical therapy schools that is an academic department of a medical school. Our goal for decades has been to join the other medical school clinical departments in having full privileges to participate in the tripartite Education, Research and Clinical Practice missions of the academic medical center. In September we signed a historic agreement with Northwestern Memorial HealthCare (NMHC) allowing us to accomplish that goal.

With this agreement, NUPTHMS becomes a full participant within the Northwestern Medicine integrated academic health system that is the shared strategic vision of NMHC (the clinical entity), with Northwestern University's Feinberg School of Medicine, of which we are a department. We believe NUPTHMS's academic-clinical partnerships with Shirley Ryan AbilityLab and NMHC provide NUPTHMS with the means to continue to excel as one of the top physical therapy schools in the U.S., and that this academic-medical center model of physical therapy education, research, and practice will allow us all to play a major role in creating and leading science-underpinned rehabilitation interventions into the future.


