POST-INTERVIEW COMMUNICATIONS

FINAL ADMISSIONS DECISIONS

Following the interview, a final holistic review is completed by the Executive Committee on Admissions. Interviewees can expect to receive notification regarding their application status starting in early December, with most final admissions decisions

being released at the end of the admission cycle, typically in early March.

AAMC ACCEPTANCE PROTOCOLS FOR APPLICANTS

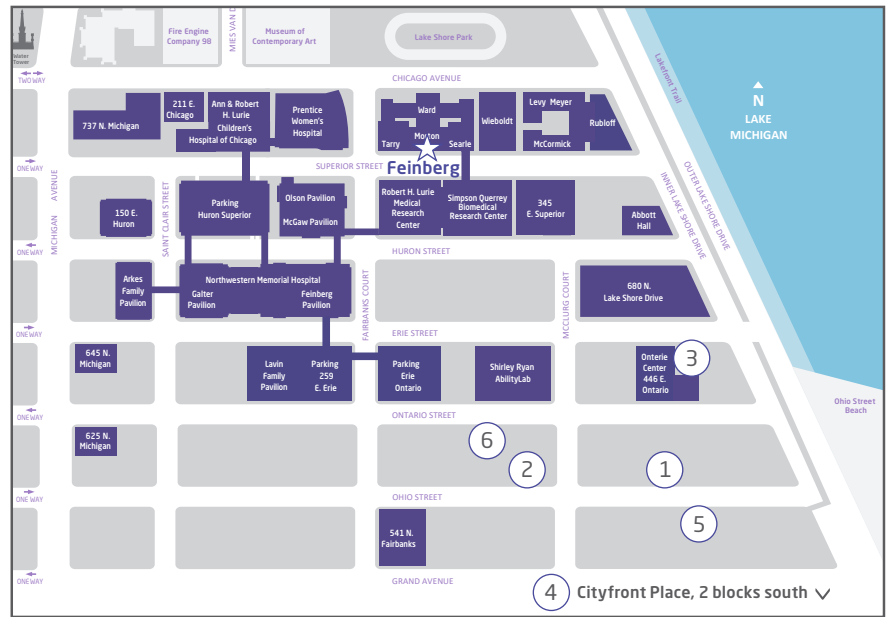
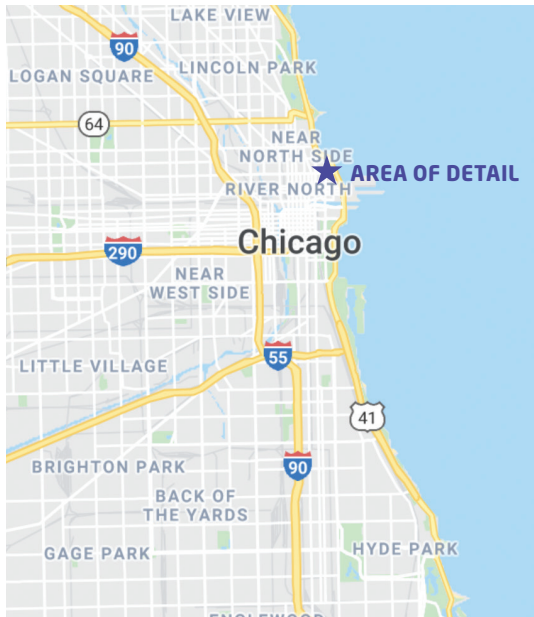
Withdraw your acceptance from any school or program you do not plan to attend as soon as you have made that decision.

On or before April 15, narrow your selection(s) to no more than three schools or programs, and withdraw your acceptance(s) from all other schools or programs.

On or before April 30, choose the school or program to which you plan to matriculate and promptly withdraw your acceptances from all other schools or programs

Living in Chicago



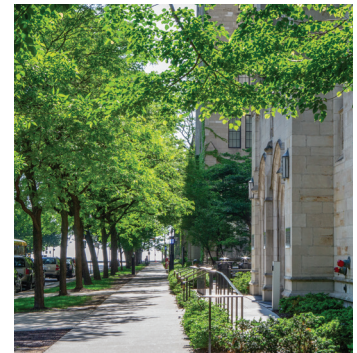
