Applying Racial Equity Lens to Research Engagement: Resource Catalog



Mistrust resulting from evident racism, discrimination and bias in research and healthcare is a key reason why underrepresented people and communities of color have negative perceptions of researchers and academic and medical institutions. Community-academic partnerships can help to increase trust, but without directly addressing race equity issues in research and the partnerships themselves, there is a risk of perpetuating and deepening inequities and mistrust.

ARCC is working to deepen our understanding of issues of race and racism in research and community engagement. As part of this, ARCC is seeking to gather and develop resources and practical tools that support research teams and community research partnerships to be more racially equitable. This is <u>not</u> a collection of general resources related to race and racism but meant to be resources most specifically of interest to researchers and community-academic research partnerships.
