

## Health Services and Outcomes Research Graduate Program 2020-2021 Academic Year Course Schedule

The Health Services and Outcomes Research (HSOR) program’s hybrid model adapts the university’s traditional course format to accommodate working clinicians and students living outside Chicago.

**Residencies** take place on the Chicago campus over three or four days each quarter. These days are comprised of intensive instruction and program events. Many courses hold **synchronous meetings** between the quarterly residencies, most of which are on-campus class meetings that support remote attendance via Blue Jeans. Attendance is mandatory for residency class sessions. If a student encounters an immovable schedule conflict with residency, he or she should inform the program director, Megan McHugh (megan-mchugh@northwestern.edu), and the relevant course instructor as early as possible.

The physical location for nearly all classes is the **18<sup>th</sup> Floor Theater Classroom, 633 N Saint Clair Street, Chicago, IL 60611**; any different locations are noted. All times listed are central time.
