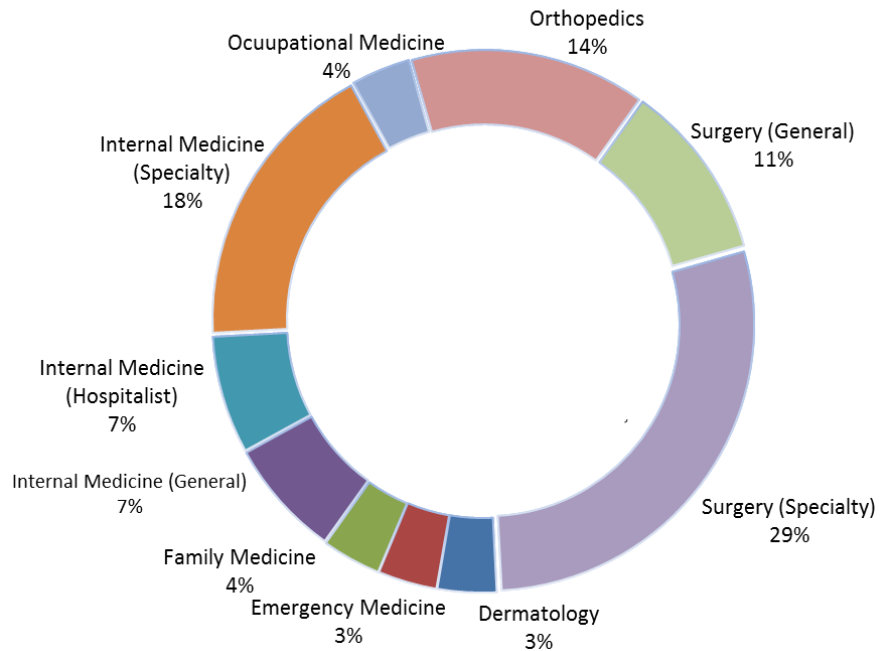

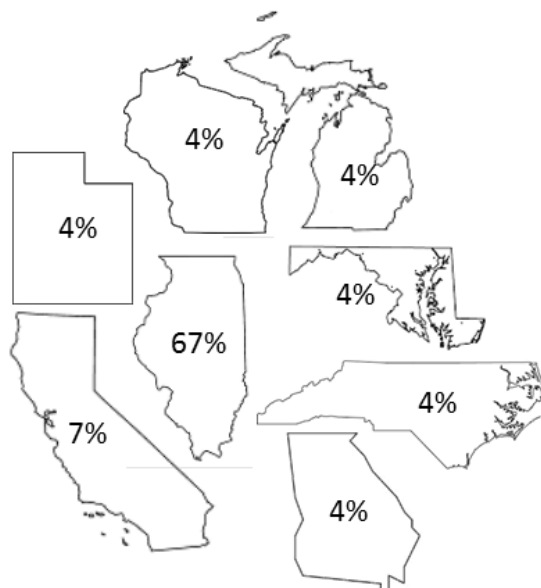

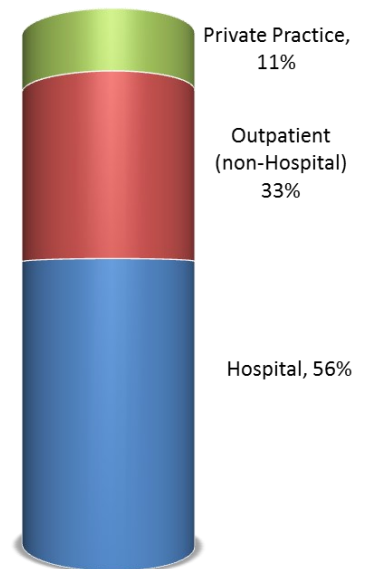
**Area of Specialty**
